Submitting an Appeal



- To submit an appeal
 - Fields in blue on the Excel document can only be corrected by submitting an updated ISEE file (May 2014 **and** June 2014 or End of Year ISEE file for districts submitting Cumulative File uploads). Contact your regional ISEE Coordinator for additional help
 - Other appeals – Medical Excuse or Extenuating Circumstances
 - ✦ Upload legitimate and relevant supporting documentation for all appeals for the student directly in the application

Submitting an Appeal



- To Submit an Appeal in the application, click on the Appeals tab
- Enter the student's EDUID and select Continue

Appeal Approval



- Appeals submitted in the Participation Rate Appeals Site will be reviewed by the Assessment Department and approved or denied.
 - If approved, the school data file will reflect the student's exclusion in the participation rate calculation
 - If denied, no other appeals will be accepted for the student
- Appeals submitted via corrected ISEE uploads will update the school data file nightly
